The Youth Services Survey for Families (YSS-F) is a survey used to document caregiver report of service experiences over the past 6 months. This special request report summarizes 40 caregiver responses from the 6-month interview. **This means that caregivers are reflecting back on their first six months in CRW.** These results are based on data available as of Dec 10, 2005.
