

**LOCAL VERSUS NATIONAL:
A COMPARISON OF DATA FROM THE DEC 05 DPR**

The Dec 2005 release of ORC MACRO's Data Profile Report (DPR) allows for comparison of Columbia River Wraparound demographics and outcomes with national data from other Phase IV sites. The table below summarizes the *comparative* highlights. Only data for which a difference between the local and national dataset was observed have been summarized.

Slide # from DPR (local)	Domain	Observation (Local versus National Data)
13	Child and Family History INTAKE	Overall, higher percentage of negative family history experiences locally (e.g., witnessed DV, lived with someone who was depressed, lived with someone convicted of a crime, lived with someone with substance abuse problem, etc)
13	Child and Family History INTAKE	About the same on percent reporting runaway, child having substance abuse problems. Local lower on attempted suicide.
20	School Attendance and Performance INTAKE	Percent of youth missing a day a week (22.7%) higher than national average (9.8%). Also, lower grades in general and a higher percentage of youth at schools that don't issue grades (local 35%; national 10%).
23	Special Education Placements INTAKE	CRW youth experience <i>resource services</i> (81%) at a much higher rate than the national average (32%). <i>Resource services</i> are special education classes in which youth are pulled out of general education for subjects of portions of the day.
28	Criminal Justice History INTAKE	Slightly higher percentages on percent of youth <i>questioned by police, arrested, or on probation.</i>
41	Anxiety & Depression Scores INTAKE to 6-MONTHS	In two of the three scales presented, local youth are getting worse instead of better. The national pattern is a decrease in anxiety and depression scores. Anxiety scores at intake and 6 months are higher than the national average.
55	Service Types received 6-MONTHS	CRW provides an average of 8.1 different services between intake and 6 months while the national average is 6.0.
59	Cultural Competency 6-MONTHS	Lower scores on cultural competency in comparison to national average.
