**Positive Comments Related to Education:
Hood River County Data from the Family Participation Survey**

This data is presented in response to the Annual Data Report to the Governance Council presentation that occurred at the Governance Council meeting in October 2008. Positive comments related to education from the Family Participation Survey have been summarized in the table below:

The school staff has done a remarkable job in helping our [daughter/son] meet [her/his] educational needs.
. School did a fantastic job - I am really pleased with the school. The cooperation has been fantastic.
I'm real pleased with the way things are going this year - we're excited about my child's stability.
Being persistent has helped, it's taken over a year to get [him/her] finally completely tested and diagnosed with a deficit. The recommendations from the testing are now being implemented in the school setting.
. . .these are very dedicated people. They are really working hard to help [him /her] succeed.
At the school [he/she] is in now, they DO deal with (his/her behavior problems) IN school.
I think its working our pretty good. It gives [him/her] incentive to be good and I reinforce it at home.
It was good. They really sat back to see how WE could help our youth help [himself/herself].
They were thorough
I think they're doing their best to do the best for my child's education.
I love [his/her] teacher - [he/she] has made it very clear that if there is anything I need changed - to let [him/her] know.
I just think it went really well. [His/her teacher] made me feel like my opinion mattered.
I thought it went really well, I think it was inspiring for [him/her].
I can't say enough about how great they've been! It's more than I could have expected.
I think they are going above and beyond.
